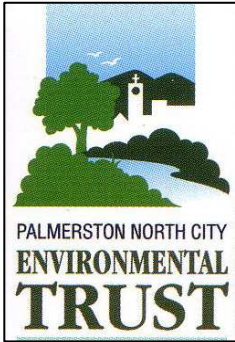


# Palmerston North City Environmental Trust



## Grants Available for Environment Projects

The **Palmerston North City Environmental Trust** (PNCET) promotes positive environmental outcomes in Palmerston North and surrounding areas by actively supporting groups and projects that enhance our natural and physical environment. One way the PNCET does this is by making resources available to community groups for use in projects with a strong environment focus, through a Contestable Grants Scheme.

### Contestable Grants:

- Support action to enhance the Environment of our City
- Funds to be allocated on the basis of the criteria below; while it is acknowledged that no project will likely meet all the criteria, successful applicants should meet as many of the criteria as possible.
- PNCET endeavours to maintain diversity in the range of projects it supports.
- A list of previously supported projects is available from the Trust.
- **Application form on the reverse side of this document.**
- **Applications are accepted anytime, but must be made at least 6 weeks prior to project commencing.**

### Criteria for contestable grant funding:

- Positive environmental impact
- Promote the environment
- Promote Kaitiakitanga
- Have in place co-funding, or potential for co-funding
- Assist Maori to maintain mauri in the environment
- Benefit to the Palmerston North natural and/or built environment
- Enhances public awareness of the environment
- Assists in the initiation of new projects
- Likelihood of success
